- Be interested in developing strong litigation and writing skills, and learning the Federal Rules of Evidence, the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedures, the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, federal sentencing procedures, the Bail Reform Act, and this District's Local Rules;
- Because effective written advocacy is crucial in federal court, you
 must submit a 5-10 page writing sample (motion, law school paper, or
 persuasive letter to opposing counsel); and
- Demonstrate a commitment to providing defense services to indigent clients.

PROGRAM SUMMARY:

- Estimated commitment length is about 1 year.
